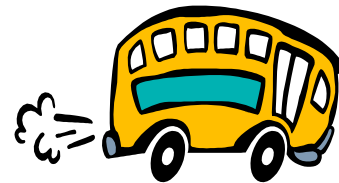

White Bear Historical Society

On **Thursday, July 21 at 2:00 pm** the White Bear Historical Society will be in the Community Room to talk about "Sophie Wirth Camp." It was the first Jewish camp in Minnesota and open from 1911 to 1943. It was also the first kosher camp in the northwest. Children were sent there to learn the Jewish faith, but also for fun and recreation, and often for their health, as good nutrition was emphasized for underweight children. Costs were kept down, allowing low income children and their mothers a week of respite from heat and city life.
