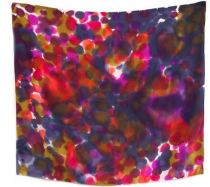


## August 2022 Newsletter

### 2nd Annual Food Truck Event



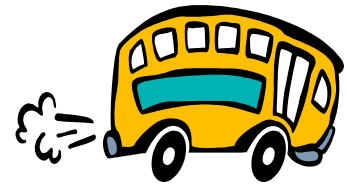

### **White Bear Historical Society**

On **Thursday, August 4 at 2:00 pm** the White Bear Historical Society will be in the Community Room to talk about "Dellwood– 100 Years & Counting." On July 14, 1917, the Village of Dellwood was incorporated, even though it was already on the map. It had been platted by the railroad 35 years prior. In 1920, the population was 87 and there were 19 homes. A decade later, the population was 90 and there were 26 homes– so the city wasn't booming. We hope you come and learn some more interesting facts about this beautiful town!
