Star Party Astronomy Night

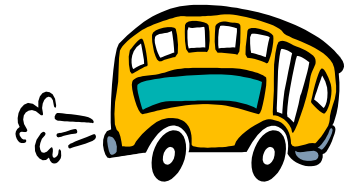
